Number Bonds to 10.

$$1 + 9 = 10$$

$$7 + 3 = 10$$

$$8 + 2 = 10$$

$$9 + 1 = 10$$

$$10 + 0 = 10$$

These number bonds are to be learnt by heart - if your child can instantly recall the number pairs to 10 they will become speedier at mental maths.

READING SKILLS

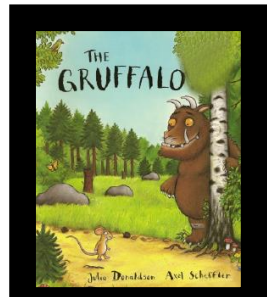
Please read your reading book with an adult at home. You now have your yellow reading record books to record in as well!
